Dear Online Students and Parents:

Students taking online courses need to be dedicated in completing the course within the time constraints. The summer courses will run from May 19<sup>th</sup> through July 21<sup>th</sup>. Students will be required to spend a minimum of 60 hours to fulfill the minimum course requirements. These courses require independent learning and self-motivation. Time management is a vital component of these courses.

When considering an online course, carefully evaluate the requirements needed to complete the course. The existence of each course is contingent upon an enrollment of at least 12 students. Each course has a maximum class size of 25 students, and please note both courses typically fill up quickly.

The **Online Computer Science** course will satisfy the graduation requirement for earning ½ credit in Computer Science. The purpose of this course is to introduce the student to programming. Students will also develop word processing, spreadsheet, and presentation software skills. Research will be enhanced with use of the Internet.

The **Online Health** course will satisfy the graduation requirement for earning ½ credit in Health.

**The application and payment are due to Mrs. Lightner in the Guidance Office by Friday, April 21st. Applications submitted on time will be awarded spots by date of submission with seniors taking priority. Applications submitted after the deadline will be considered on a first come, first serve basis.**

Returned checks will result in a \$25 service fee from the school.

### Online Health and Online Computer Science

#### **Online Health**

Grades: Current 9, 10, & 11 (Incoming 8<sup>th</sup> graders ineligible)

Teacher: Mr. Jason Ashworth (jashworth@carrollhs.org)

Course Description: This course focuses on favorable health knowledge, attitude, and practices. Health in the sense of personal fitness for a full fruitful, creative, and spiritual living is individual and community-based. To lead a student to the “door” of individual and community-based health may best be enhanced by an education to the general knowledge available with some critical thinking challenges taken from the text offerings.

Text: Glencoe Health (2011) in Carroll’s bookstore is compulsory before school year closing.

#### **Online Computer Science Principles**

Grades: Current 9, 10, & 11 (Incoming 8<sup>th</sup> graders ineligible)

Teacher: Mrs. Diane Keller (dkeller@carrollhs.org)

Course Description: This course is for students who have average keyboarding and computer skills. Students will develop or improve their knowledge of documents, spreadsheets, and presentation software. This course introduces students to the central ideas of computer science. Students will investigate the innovations that computing has made possible and examine ethical implication of new computing technologies. To participate in this course, students must have daily access to the Internet. All course requirements and grades are available on an Online Learning Management System (Blackboard is currently being used). Note: The course will not appear on Net Classroom.
