David Gasper Class of 1974

In 1983, David Gasper founded Gasper Corporation and developed ATM management software for leading banks such as Bank of America and Royal Bank of Scotland. Gasper products use automation to remotely manage ATMs and the systems that support ATMs, such as hardware service teams, telecommunications networks, and cash replenishment teams.



In 1999, NCR Corporation acquired Gasper Corporation. Today, Gasper exists as a subsidiary operation of NCR. The Gasper name and brand is still known worldwide as a pioneer and innovator in the ATM industry.

Dave earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business from Wright State University in 1978. He received his M.B.A. degree from the University of Dayton in 1984. He won the 1998 Ernst & Young Entrepreneur of the Year Award and the 1998 Greene County Special Award. Dave was also inducted into Carroll High School's Inaugural Distinguished Alumni Hall of Fame in 2008.

Dave started two other business ventures after selling Gasper Corporation and is active in promoting entrepreneur activities throughout the Dayton area. He serves as advisory board member of several privately held high technology businesses, was the President of a private placement venture capital fund, a former teacher and executive in residence at the Raj Sooin School of Business, and a former volunteer chairman of the CEO Development program sponsored by the Chamber of Commerce.

Dave recently retired and resides in Beavercreek, Ohio, with his wife, Theresa. All three of their children attended Carroll: Laura Gasper '01, Brian Duckro '02, and Carly Duckro '04. Dave states: "Carroll High School had a great impact on me. I received an incredible education along with important values that have lasted my entire life. My high school experience prepared me for college, business, parenting, and the many challenges in my life. I am pleased that our children graduated from Carroll."

The Gaspers have a vision for the Dayton region, and it's founded on a stronger economy.
