Dr. Mark Stibich is a founder, inventor and an infectious diseases epidemiologist. His broad areas of expertise include fundraising, disease prevention, healthcare information technology, business development, startups, and medical devices with specific expertise in infectious diseases.



Mark holds a leadership position as the Founder/Chief Scientific Officer of Xenex, Inc., where he is responsible for intellectual property (he is an inventor on over 120 granted patents), publishing product results in peer-reviewed journals, designing proof of effectiveness studies and collaborating with medical and research staff at over 500 hospital customers in the U.S. & abroad.
