This scholarship is awarded to 8th grade students who will enter their freshman year at Carroll High School in memory of two of Carroll's former principals. Students in the freshman class will be awarded \$500 to \$2,500 for tuition expenses incurred for the freshman year based on End of Year Academic Grades for 7th and 8th grade, the 7th grade IOWA Assessment Complete Composite Score, and an essay question. The scholarship is renewable each year providing the student maintains a 3.5 GPA and adheres to all behavior standards in the student handbook.
