




ABOUT US

SERVICES

At Carroll, most intervention students receive one period a day of individualized instruction with an Intervention Specialist. Instruction provided to students is based on their IEP/SP and varies based on their identified needs. Common areas of instruction include reading comprehension, mathematics problem solving and calculation, written expression, and study skills and organization, and social skills. Many students are also provided additional support within their general education classroom through a co-teaching model. Furthermore, Carroll offers Speech and Language services from a licensed Speech and Language Pathologist, for those students with IEP/SP goals relating to this area.
