The Carroll Art Scholarship is for the 2021-2022 school year and is open to current 8th graders that plan to attend Carroll their Freshman year. ## **Visual Arts Scholarship**

This \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded to a student with a passion to share his or her artistic talents. Applicants must submit 5 pieces of art as well as 5 sketches via email (as indicated in student application), have a 4.0 GPA in art classes, submit a student application form, and submit a recommendation form from an art teacher. If chosen for this scholarship, the student agrees to commit to at least eight semesters of the core art curriculum courses, and become part of the Carroll High School art community by joining the National Art Honor Society for as long as s/he receives the scholarship while also maintaining a 4.0 in art courses.
