- AP U.S. History

Politics and Government (½ credit)

- College Prep Politics and Government or
- Honors Politics and Government or
- A.P. Politics and Government (full year course, ½ credit each semester)

Elective (½ credit) - Choose from these options:

- Introduction to Economics Course includes: national economic system,
 American economy, role of federal government and Federal Reserve System,
 interest rates, dividends, taxes, budget and stocks
- Introduction to Sociology Focuses on human social behavior, culture, socialization and development of personality, group interaction, problems in society
- Introduction to Psychology Topic include human behavior, human development, abnormal psychology (disorders), learning, memory, treatment of disorders
- Current Events Discussion of current people and topics in the news
- Modern History This course focuses on how history is shown through movies and how movies impact history
- A.P. Psychology Prepares students for the Advanced Placement Testing 9 topics including: personality development, psychological disorders and treatment of disorders, learning, thinking, memory, human biology and development, and intelligence
- A.P. Macroeconomics Studying how economic systems develop, the role of government in the economy, the global marketplace, and finance
