Dear Students and Parents,

After the challenges of the past school year, I am very happy to be looking ahead to the 2021-2022 school year. We will always place student health and safety as our highest priority, but as of now our plans are to return all Patriots to in-person learning.

The 2021-2022 school year will begin on Monday, August 16, 2021. On this day, **freshmen** will have a full day starting at 8:00 a.m. **New transfer students** will attend an orientation session from 8:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. ALL STUDENTS are to report to school on Tuesday, August 17 by 8:00 a.m. As has been the case throughout the pandemic, **all plans are subject to change** and we will communicate any changes to you as soon as possible.

Everyone is asked to pick up class schedules on Wednesday, August 4, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. If there is a problem with your schedule or you need to change a class, see the secretary in the Guidance Office on this day to make an appointment. The band and guard will be holding a Used Uniform Sale during these hours or until the merchandise is gone. The Spirit Shop will be open that day for purchase of spirit wear and our new quarter zip uniform pullover.

Carroll students will be required to have an ID card in their possession at all times. This card can be used as a debit card to purchase lunch, check out textbooks from the bookstore, and can be used for admittance at all home athletic events. Returning students will have their badges ready on the first day of school using pictures from last school year. However, **ALL new students must have their picture taken on August 4 during schedule pick up.** All students who drive to school will need to purchase a parking pass. Information on this process was sent to students via email earlier in the summer.

We would like to remind you that **before your student can get his/her schedule you will need to** access your Family Portal to complete the enrollment/re-enrollment process. You should have received information regarding this to the email address you provided Carroll High School. Any questions should be directed to ndruck@carrollhs.org.

Please feel free to contact us with any questions. Summer office hours are Monday through Thursday from 7:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. The building will be closed from June 26 – July 11. I hope the rest of your summer is safe and enjoyable!

Dear Patriot and Parents:

As Athletic Director at Carroll High School, I would like to welcome everyone back to another exciting year of Carroll High School Athletics! For those new to our family, welcome to the home of the **PATRIOTS!** Our faculty, administration and coaching staff are very excited about the opportunity to work with you in these all-important high school years. A number of you have chosen to be involved with athletic teams while at Carroll. The following information outlines requirements to participate, including academic eligibility, athletic forms, conditioning times for fall sports, and fall tryout information.

Listed below are starting dates and times for fall sports along with other valuable information.

MANDATORY MEETING: The OHSAA requires a mandatory meeting for parents and student-athletes prior to the start of each season. The meeting for all Fall sports will be held on Wednesday, August 4, 2021. The meeting will begin at 6:00 PM in the school cafeteria. Topics covered will include, eligibility; school policies regarding athletics; and state regulations.

ATHLETIC REGISTRATION AND ATHLETIC FORMS: Information on athletic registration and mandatory athletic forms is available on Carroll's website under the "Athletics" tab. Student-Athletes and Parents must complete and electronically sign all athletic forms through their FinalForms account prior to participating with any team.

FOOTBALL: Carroll Football summer camp and practice will begin on July 6th at 8:00am. Players are expected in the locker room by 7:30am. Athletes will need a blue shirt, practice jersey, black shorts, a water bottle and football cleats. Strength and conditioning for High School Football will be held throughout the summer. ELIGIBILITY: Academic eligibility for Student-Athletes can be confusing. *You are encouraged to call the Athletic Office if you have questions.* In order to be eligible, students need to pass at least five one-credit courses or the equivalent (each of which count toward graduation). Complete information can be found by visiting the OHSAA website, www.ohsaa.org and selecting the eligibility link.

ATHLETIC PARTICIPATION FEES: First sport is \$185.00, second sport is \$170.00, and third sport is \$160.00. There is a family maximum of \$675.00. FACTS will bill you once a team roster has been established.

VOLUNTEER: Parents, grandparents, family and friends; if you are interested in helping with maintaining the outside athletic facilities, taking tickets, or working the concessions, please call the Athletic Office at 937.253.3212. We could use any time you may have to offer.

DIRECTIONS AND GAME SITES: Directions and game sites for the GCL Co-ed (Greater Catholic League, Co-ed Division) are available at www.gclsports.com. You may also access the sites from Carroll's home page.

SCHEDULES AVAILABLE ONLINE: Athletic schedules will be available online (www.carrollhs.org) prior to the start of each season. Occasionally we experience computer-feed problems that link the schedules to Carroll's website. We apologize in advance for any problems this may cause. (Note: please be sure to select the current school year in the dropdown box at the top of the page.)

For the second year, Carroll will be utilizing Shaheen's Uniform Store as the sole provider of uniforms for our students. Students can continue wearing the Land's End uniforms for as long as they fit and are in good condition. Only uniforms purchased through Shaheen's or previously purchased through Lands' End will be permitted, and all items must be embroidered with the proper Carroll logos.

The annual used uniform sale will be held on schedule pick-up day, August 4. More details will be coming about that event over the summer. Additionally, the crewneck sweatshirt that was sold in the Spirit Shop will no longer be available for purchase as it is no longer an approved uniform item. It was replaced by a quarter zip pull-over that can be purchased from Shaheen's or in our Spirit Shop.

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENT SUCCESS REGARDING ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

THE CARROLL DRESS CODE

Carroll students are expected to be dressed in a neat and presentable manner at all times. The administration reserves the right to require any student dressed inappropriately to change before attending classes or to leave a school sponsored activity. Uniforms must be purchased from Sheehan Uniform Company and have the Carroll logo properly adorned.

***Personal Appearance Standards (enforced at all times) ***

1. Extremes in hairstyle (such as man buns), jewelry, make-up and attire are not permitted.
2. Tattoos (body art) must be covered during the school day and/or at school sponsored events.
3. Any head covering – hats, scarves, bandannas - should be removed while in the building.
4. Facial hair is prohibited during all school hours regardless of whether the student is in uniform or not.
5. No slippers, UGG slipper shoes, flip flops, sandals, slides, high heeled shoes, heeled boots, or Crocs.
6. No facial piercings, mouth piercings or gauges in ears. Small studs in the nose are acceptable.
7. Hair must be neat, clean and appropriate for an internship interview. Experimentation with hairstyles are not acceptable during the school year. Boys are not permitted to have “man buns” and hair must not touch collar.

DAILY DRESS CODE

1. Uniform pants or shorts worn at the waist. Female students may wear the approved skort.
2. Belts are required with all pants and shorts. Buckles are not to have any words or symbols. Excessively large or inappropriate buckles will be confiscated and the students will receive a demerit.
3. Uniform shorts/skorts length cannot be altered and CHS logo must be visible
4. Polo shirt in red or blue with Carroll logo (even worn under pullovers)
5. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
6. Carroll uniform tops purchased through Sheehan Uniform Company or in the approved Spirit Shop section may be worn over uniform polo shirts. Hoodies (even Carroll issued) are not allowed!
7. Solid color red, blue, black or white T-shirts may be worn under the uniform. NO printing on the shirt should be visible.
8. Gym or dress shoes (in good repair)
9. Socks must be worn
10. Boys may wear a solid color shirt and tie with a plain t-shirt underneath.

Any student not in compliance with the uniform code will be issued a demerit for each violation that day or may be sent home to dress in the appropriate uniform. Students sent home to change are responsible for work missed and will not be given extra time to complete assignments.

OUT OF UNIFORM DRESS CODE

1. Students may wear: jeans, shorts, skirts, capris or pants in good repair and worn at the waist.
2. Girls may wear yoga pants, as long as they are SOLID BLACK, (no other color allowed) and the proper top is worn with them as to be considered an appropriate length such as “tunic length”.
3. No short shorts, spandex, swim trunks or short skirts (shorts and skirts are to be longer than (“Finger- tip” length).
4. Pants are to be worn in good condition. No rips or holes may be visible.
5. No tank tops, halter tops or straps showing.
6. Shoulders must be covered at all times.
7. Shirts must be of a length that can be tucked in
8. No low-cut shirts or low-cut V-necks (no more than 2 in. below the collar bone.)
9. No hats or headgear of any kind.
10. No clothing related to alcohol or tobacco or having foul language or sexual messages.
11. Heavy coats and head coverings (including hoods) must be removed and placed in the student’s locker upon entering the building at any time.
12. Undergarments must not be visible
13. No pajama bottoms
14. Students may wear open toed shoes or sandals without socks
15. In the second semester, seniors are permitted to wear college shirts on Wednesday. No college athletic jerseys may be worn.

SPIRIT DAY DRESS CODE (FRIDAYS ONLY)

1. Approved issued school pants, shorts, or skorts
2. Carroll attire that is predominantly red, white, grey, black, pink and /or royal blue.
3. Carroll approved athletic tops are permitted.
4. Carroll sponsored athletic and club shirts
5. Carroll gear purchased in the spirit shop
6. Shirts that recognize school accomplishments (i.e. OHSAA tournament t-shirts)
7. On House Shirt days, uniform pants, shorts & skorts will be required and only House Shirts or uniform shirts may be worn.

Beginning the 2021-2022 school year, WG Grinders Cafeteria Operations will partner with MySchoolAccount.com for managing lunch services for our students. MySchoolAccount.com offers parents the ability to make deposits directly into their student's account online or via their mobile app. You will also be able to track your children's purchases, transfer funds between siblings and set low balance reminders. Deposits and payments can be made using checking/savings accounts or credit/debit cards. We will still accept payments in the cafeteria at the register. You may pay by check (made out to WG Grinders), credit card or cash. The account will be updated in real time, so the balance information will be current. There will be a \$2.00 per transaction convenience fee for online deposits using checking or savings accounts and a 4.75% fee for using credit/debit cards.

In order to take advantage of this service, you will need to create a parent account. In order to do this please follow these instructions:

1. Go to www.MySchoolAccount.com
2. Click "Create Account" on the top menu bar.
3. Fill in the required information on the "Parent Account Sign-Up" page.
4. Select OH for the state.
5. Create a User ID and Password.
6. Choose WG Grinders from the "School District" drop down menu.
7. Click the "Accept" box and then click "Signup." You will receive an email that will contain a "verification code".

After you receive the verification code, you can add your student's information. You will need to log in to MySchoolAccount.com again using your new User ID and Password. You will then complete the following steps:

1. Enter the verification code you received to verify your email address.
2. Begin adding your student's information according to the guidelines provided. You will need your student's ID number (the number starts with their graduation year followed by four digits). Use this number with CHS as a prefix. Example: CHS20250000.
3. Repeat step two for all of your children that attend Carroll.
4. After your student(s) are added, you will be able to make payments and view transaction history.

Any money that was left on your child's account at the end of the 2020-2021 school year will be transferred to the new system automatically. No action is required of you for this to occur.

Carroll High School is not responsible for any vehicle damage and/or lost/stolen items from a vehicle. Parents are responsible for any vehicle facility, and/or property damage and coinciding cost (including medical/hospital bills) accrued on school grounds.

Carroll High School students and coinciding parent/guardian must read, agree to and sign-off on the following terms/conditions in order to obtain a parking permit as well as the ability to drive to school and park on the Carroll High School property during the 2021-22 school year:

- Carroll High School students must understand that driving/parking on Carroll grounds is a privilege, and Carroll students will enter and exit the school property in a respectful and safe manner at all times while following the appropriate school driving pattern.
- Carroll students may only park in their assigned/designated area during the appropriate times.
- Parking Permits must be used every school day from 7:15 a.m. to 3:15 p.m. Open parking takes place after 3:15 p.m. each school day and all day on non-school days. Parking permits are not in effect during these times.
- Carroll students must display their parking pass at all times on their rearview mirror.
- During the Marching Band season in the fall, the parking lot beyond the gate (Back 40) is used for the band practice area after school. Since this is the only space available for band practice at this time, students are required to have their vehicle removed from the practice area by 3:20 p.m. Failure to move a vehicle may result in detention, demerits, Saturday school, and/or potentially being towed at the owner’s expense.
- Carroll students found violating parking regulations or failing to drive cautiously/respectfully while following the school driving pattern will be subject to disciplinary action by the Assistant Principal, including demerits, detention, Saturday school, and/or the revoking of parking privileges.
