Senior Awards Assembly

- Students should report to the gym after the last senior final exam. Please enter by the boys' locker room and exit by the cafeteria side of the stage.
- If you are having problems with your cap and gown (sizing/fit), stop in the main office on Wednesday or Thursday (May 18th or 19th).
- Students will be presented the cover for your diploma during the graduation ceremony. Gowns and stoles will be returned immediately after the ceremony and will be exchanged for your diploma.
- Please take any and all pictures with your cap and gown prior to the graduation ceremony Friday night at Trent Arena.
- Attendance for mass is MANDATORY this is part of graduation any student not attending Baccalaureate Mass will NOT walk during the graduation ceremony.
- Graduates' immediate family is strongly encouraged to attend

 Baccalaureate Mass. There is limited seating for mass. Please keep the guest list to 6 family members. If you need to increase that number, please reach out to Mr. Sableski (msableski@carrollhs.org) ASAP regarding the need for additional seating at Mass.
- Gowns are worn at Baccalaureate Mass, but seniors do not wear caps for Mass.
- All students must report by 6:30 p.m. to your family room teacher in the church basement. Seniors will be lined up after attendance for the procession.
- We encourage participation in the Liturgy in celebration of our seniors.
- Dress Code:
 - Boys: MUST wear a shirt, tie, and dress pants. No jeans or shorts. Also, socks and dress shoes are required. No tennis shoes. You must be clean shaven, and have hair off the collar per handbook policy.
 - Girls: Wear a dress, dress pants, or skirt and shirt with appropriate shoes. Be mindful of colors and patterns as the gowns are somewhat transparent. No tennis shoes.
- All seniors must be in the gym Attendance is **mandatory**.
- The Awards Ceremony on Friday morning will be graduates and invitation only seating. Breakfast will be served to graduates after the ceremony. Invitation to parents and guests for the ceremony will be required due to limited seating. The Awards Ceremony will be live streamed.
- The Awards Ceremony is followed by breakfast in the cafeteria for seniors only.
- Dress Code:
 - Boys: MUST wear dress slacks and dress shoes. No tennis shoes. No jeans or shorts. You must be clean shaven, and have hair off the collar per handbook policy.
 - Girls A dress, dress pants or skirt. No revealing tops. No bare midriffs. No shorts or jeans! Skirts and dresses must be no shorter than 4" above the knee. Be mindful of the shoes worn. Take note of heel height, you will be walking up and down stairs for both awards and graduation.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- You may park in any of the areas by the school, however, please be sure NOT to park in spaces reserved for the Fitness/Wellness Center Thank You!
- Attendance is **mandatory** for practice.
- Take assigned seats on the floor for practice as soon as you arrive. (Seating assignment forthcoming) expect to stay till 12:30 p.m. Mr. Derus, Mrs. Kilby and Mr. Sableski will assist you.
- **Do not change places**. This is the order your name will be called at graduation.
- Note your ROW and NUMBER. Also, familiarize yourself with the person who is next to you on both sides.
- We do not wear caps and gowns at this rehearsal.
- Students who have parts in graduation should stay after rehearsal to practice those parts.
- You may park in any of the areas by the school, however, please be sure NOT to park in spaces reserved for the Fitness/Wellness Center Thank You!
- All seniors must report by 6:30 p.m.
- Seniors will assemble in the assigned Athletic Center Gym of Kettering and check in.
- Dress Code is the same as at Baccalaureate (see above).
- Students will wear their cap and gown.
- Wear tassel on the right side of the cap. After conference of diplomas, Mr. Sableski will instruct you to turn your tassel to the left side of the cap. A signal will be given for this transfer.
- Upon recessional, students will return to their assigned staging area to turn in their gown. Students will need to remove all their medals and awards.
 Captains will turn in their stole and receive a cord. Students will receive their diploma at that time.
- <u>Seating for graduation is unlimited.</u> Seating is on a first come, first served basis. There will be limited handicap seating, and if you need this special seating, please contact Mr. Derus (<u>gderus@carrollhs.org</u>) ASAP. Trent Arena is wheelchair accessible, and there is an elevator. Wheelchair seating is on the track level of the arena.

Easterling will be taking individual pictures of students as they receive their diplomas. Proofs will be mailed from Easterling along with purchase information. There is no obligation to purchase a graduation picture from Easterling. Parents/Guests should not approach the stage to take pictures during graduation as Easterling Studios will be taking photos.

Please look for additional communication regarding the live streaming for the award ceremony, Baccalaureate Mass, and graduation.

There are to be **no air horns, noisemakers, or other items that distract during the graduation ceremony**. These items will be confiscated by the Trent Arena security and you may be asked to leave. **Trent Arena prohibits silly string and confetti.**

NO FOOD OR DRINK WILL BE ALLOWED IN TRENT ARENA AT ANY TIME. PLEASE MAKE SURE TO RESPECT THE RULES OF OUR HOST FACILITY.
