Patrick Barrentine '03: Football, Wrestling

Patrick achieved 6 varsity letters: swimming (1), football (2), and wrestling (3). He placed in Division I State Wrestling 3x: 2001 (2nd place), 2002 (3rd place), and 2003 (state champion). He was a 3x league champ (2001-03); 3x 1st Team All-Area (2001-03); 3x sectional champ (2001-03); 2x district champ (2001-02); and 2x Greco Roman National Champ (2001-02). Patrick competed in China with the cadet world team in 2001. Other accolades he received was 8x All-American; Freestyle National Champ (2002); 3rd at senior nationals (2003); and State Duals MVP (2003). Patrick was the Greater Miami Valley Wrestling Association wrestler of the year in 2003. His career record was 135-13.



Jeff Popella '06: Soccer

Jeff achieved 3 varsity letters in soccer. He received Miami Valley District Team (2004-05); 1st Team All-Area South (2004-05); 1st Team MML (2004-05); NSCAA/ADIDAS High School All-American (2005); NSCAA Region V Team (2005); 1st Team All-State (2005); State Division II Player of the Year (2005); Miami Valley Division II Player of the Year (2005); and MML North Co-Player of the Year (2005). Jeff was also athlete of the year (2006), and was 3rd all-time goals scored in a career (65), and 4th in all-time assists in a career (37). He also played 4 years for the University of Dayton and then signed with the Dayton Dutch Lions F.C. in their inaugural season.



Jordan Jennewine '07: Basketball, Track, Cross Country

Jordan achieved the 4C award in both track and cross country, plus 2 in basketball (10 varsity letters). In basketball, she received Most Improved (2005). In cross country, she received All-Greene County (2003); 1st Team MML (2003-05); All-District team (2004); MVP (2004-06); All-Region team (2005-06); and 1st Team GGCL, Academic All-Ohio, and All-State, finishing 23rd at state (2006). In track, she was Most Improved and smashed the school record in the 800m run in a time of 2:17.52 for 5th place at the regional finals. She also received All-League Honors for 800m run (2005); MVP (2005-07); Coaches Award & 2nd in Districts in the 800m run (2006); athlete of the year (2007); and 2nd team GGCL Grey Division & Wendy's High School Heisman Nominee (2007). At Ohio State, she broke records in the 1500m and distance medley relay and received 1st team All-Big Ten Track and Cross Country, 2x NCAA cross country qualifier, All-Ohio Runner of the Year, and 2x NCAA track regional qualifier.



Andrew Trick '09: Track, Cross Country

Andrew achieved the 4C award in both track and cross country (8 varsity letters). In cross country, he received 2nd team MML (2005); 3x regional qualifier (2005, 2007, 2008, finishing 1st junior year); 4x state qualifier (2005-08, finishing 11th sophomore year and 8th junior/senior year); 1st Team GCL North (2006-08), GCL North Runner of the Year (2006-08), GCL North Champion (2006); MVP (2006-08); All-Ohio Team (2007); and Patriot Award (2008). In track, he received the team Coaches Award, 1st place in league for 3200m relay, 2nd team GCL for 800m run and 1600m relay, and district meet finished 2nd in 800m run (2007); MVP (2008-09); GCL championships 1st in the 800m run, 1600m run, 3200m relay (2008-09), 1600m relay (2009); districts 2nd in 1600m run (setting a school record) and 3200m relay (2008); regionals 2nd in 1600m run and 3rd in the 3200m relay (2008, setting a school record); state 8th in the 1600m run (2008); and GCL Co-Runner of the Year, 1st in the 3200m relay, and state qualifier in the 3200m relay (2009).



Jonathon Buschur '10: Soccer

Jonathon achieved the 4C award in soccer. Highlights of his Carroll career include: 2nd team GCL North (2007); 3rd Team All-Area South (2007); 1st team GCL North (2008-09); 1st Team Miami Valley South (2008-09); and NSCAA/ADIDAS High School All-American Team, NSCAA/ADIDAS All-Region IV Team (central), 1st Team All-State, Miami Valley District Team, Academic All-Ohio, Miami Valley Division II Player of the Year, and GCL North Player of the Year (all in 2009). Jonathon was also captain his senior year. During his high school career, Carroll posted a 56-9-7 record and he was a member of the 2008 state team.



Kelley Austria '12: Basketball

Kelley achieved the 4C award in girls basketball. Her accomplishments include: 2nd Team GGCL (2009); Southwest District 15 Underclassmen All-Star Team (2009, 11); MVP (2010-12); 1st Team GGCL (2010-12); 1st Team DDN (2010-12); Honorable Mention All-State (2010); DDN Player of the Year (2011-12); Southwest District 15 Player of the Year (2011-12); Jim Dabbelt All-Star Team and Player of the Year (2011); All-Southwest Ohio 1st Team (2011); Division II State Championship MVP (Carroll finished as runner-up-2011); 2nd Team All-Ohio (2011); Division II Ohio Player of the Year (2012); Rae Burick Women in Sports Award Runner-Up (2012); Southwest District 15 All-Star Team (2012); Ms. Ohio Finalist (2012); and 529 career steals (was 5th all-time in Ohio history). Some Carroll records include single season assists to turnover ratio (2011-12), FG% (2012), FT% (2012), career FG% (2010-12: 55%), assists (2010-12: 394), and steals (2009-12: 529).



Jonah Rieman '13: Swimming

Jonah achieved the 4C award in swimming. He received the following accolades: Newcomer Award (2010); 1st Team GCL (2010-13); state prelims school record in the 200 yard freestyle relay, finishing 16th place in the finals (2011); MVP (2012-13); GCL North Swimmer of the Year (2012-13); school record in the 50 yard freestyle at the districts (2012); school record for the 200 yard freestyle relay with a time of 1:31.98 (2012); districts 2nd place in the 50 yard freestyle, breaking the school record again (2013); 2nd place in the 100 yard freestyle (2013); state 6th place in both the 50 and 100 yard freestyle (2013); and 11th place in both of his relays (2013). Other accomplishments include: GCL individual champ 12 times, All-Ohio 7 times, Penn Station Athlete of the Month, and Subway Athlete of the Week. School records he broke at the time were in the 50 yard freestyle, 200 yard medley relay, 200 and 400 yard freestyle relay.



Donna Palivec '70: Special Contributor

Donna was one of the first great female athletes that attended Carroll before Title IX was signed. She participated in intramural type activities her junior and senior year, participating in bowling, volleyball and softball. She attended Indiana University where she played volleyball for 3 years (1971-73), named state champions in 1971; she swam for 2 years (1971-72), participating in the AIAW National Swimming Championships; she played basketball and field hockey 1 year (1973), placing 4th in the 1973 AIAW National Basketball Championships; and lastly, she played softball all 4 years. She then coached high school teams from 1974-1978: boys & girls swimming, girls track, girls basketball, and girls softball. In girls track, she coached a 3-time state champion in the 880 and a 2-time in the mile. In girls swimming, she coached a 2-time state champion in the 100 yard butterfly. From 1978-1986 she was the head women's volleyball coach at North Dakota State University with a 9-year record of 336-160. At NDSU she coached 4 NCAA Division II All-Americans; 1 Olympic Bronze Medalist; and was inducted into the NDSU Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998. She also coached volleyball for 5 years at Montana State University and 8 years at Bemidji State University. She served as a USA Volleyball coaching educator (1992-93); American Volleyball Coaches Association director of membership services (1992-94); NCAA Division II North Central Region Volleyball committee member (1995); NACWAA/HERS Institute on Women in Athletic Administration participant (1995); NCAA Division II North Central Region Volleyball committee chairperson, and NCAA Division II National Volleyball committee member (1996-98). Donna was inducted into the BSU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2017; received the Leann Grotke Award at Indiana University in 2017; and was inducted into the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Hall of Fame in 2018.

2010 State Champion Soccer Team

Carroll won its third state championship in soccer, and second under Coach Scott Molfenter, in the fall of 2010. The season record was 19-2-2. The 2010 team was GCL North Champions, Regional Champions, District Champions, and State Champions. They were awarded the OSSCA Team Academic Award. The team ranked 4th in the final NSCAA/ADIDAS Region V Poll, 3rd in the final Division II State Coaches Poll, and 1st in the final Division II Miami Valley Coaches Poll.
