In this role, he leads a team of 60 human resources professionals to support an organization with over 10,000 employees. Prior to J.Crew, Jose was Vice President, Human Resources for Levi Strauss & Co. Americas division with responsibility for over 8,000 employees across the region. Jose also spent 10 years at Gap Inc. in several executive positions including the international human resources leader for Gap brand based in London, head of global HR for Banana Republic, and leading HR for the Gap Inc. Japan business based in Tokyo. Earlier in his career, Jose was responsible for driving the people integration agenda for Diageo during its acquisition of the Joseph E. Seagram business. He also has served in various global human resources leadership roles in Godiva, Campbell Soup and Nabisco.
