Jason Casebolt is an engineering and business executive with nearly 20 years of experience at The Boeing Company in Aerospace Supply Chain, Operations and Quality positions. He has worked with suppliers in China, India, and South Korea, and lived overseas in Malaysia.

Jason currently works as the Director of Product Development Quality for Boeing Commercial Airplanes (BCA). In his role, he leads teams throughout quality and engineering to identify new approaches and technologies that will improve future aircraft. Prior to his current position, Jason held roles as the Head of Quality Engineering for BCA, the Superintendent of Quality Assurance for the 737Max program, and the Expatriate Director of Quality at Aerospace Composites Malaysia, a Boeing joint venture. In the latter position, Jason was recognized through Boeing and Aviation Week for pioneering new approaches to quality that combine traditional concepts with modern Artificial Intelligence to increase the speed and scale of improvements. Earlier in his career, Jason worked as a supply chain negotiator before taking leadership positions at Boeing in Quality project management, Data Science & Analytics, and Digital Business Transformation.

Jason currently lives in the greater Seattle Area with his two children (Jackson and Hannah). He credits several experiences at Carroll with still helping him today, such as the leadership lessons through Mrs. Edwards' Junior Achievement organization, Public Speaking fundamentals through Mr. Sableski's class, and high standards for technical writing through Miss Downey's (Mrs. Clark's) Senior Seminar in Research and Expository Writing.
